<i>Yield :</i>	<i>40 to 50 hectolitres per hectare</i>
<i>Wine-making methods</i>	<i>Traditional. Control of temperatures</i> <i>Maceration : 3 to 4 weeks</i>
<i>Maturing :</i>	<i>70 % tanks 30 % barrels</i>
